
This is a request pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140, for inspection and copies of the following:

Any and all documents and recordings available under FOIA, whether in print or electronic format, related to the erection of an advertising display – which may be referred to as “street furniture” by the City’s supplier of these displays, JCDecaux, or may otherwise be referred to – on the northwest corner of LaSalle and Division streets in Chicago.
2. Any and all documents and recordings available under FOIA, whether in print or electronic format, related to the removal of an advertising display – which may be referred to as “street furniture” by the City’s supplier of these displays, JCDecaux, or may otherwise be referred to – on the northwest corner of LaSalle and Division streets in Chicago.
3. Any and all documents and recordings available under FOIA, whether in print or electronic format, referencing or otherwise related to the content of an advertising display the northwest corner of LaSalle and Division streets in Chicago.
4. Any and all documents and recordings available under FOIA referencing or otherwise related to the advertising or public outreach of the organization, “Aid for Women.”
