In recent years, the Girl Scouts USA and many local Girl Scouts councils have been supporting and promoting pro-abortion groups like Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion chain.

The Girl Scouts offered similar praise to Department of Health and Human Services Secretary Kathleen Sebelius, who is responsible for the “HHS Mandate,” which forces employers to provide free abortion-inducing drugs in their health plans, regardless of their religious or moral objections.



The Girl Scouts standard curriculum recommends as role models abortion advocates like Gloria Steinem, Betty Friedan and Hillary Clinton and radical feminist groups like the National Organization for Women.



Across the country, local Girl Scout councils honor and promote abortion advocates and pro-abortion politicians, encourage girls to work with organizations that fight for abortion on demand, and invite girls to attend events related to abortion rights advocacy and other controversial issues.
