ANTI-ABORTION ACTIVISTS COALITION FORMED IN WISCONSIN. SETS  
AGENDA FOR "YEAR OF PAIN" FOR THE AMERICAN ABORTION INDUSTRY

Meeting in Appleton Wisconsin April 12-13 national leaders of the activist wing of the anti-abortion movement voted to form a national network of activist organizations, the Pro-Life Action Network (PLAN) and planned nationally coordinated direct action activities aimed at shutting down the abortion industry.

PLAN's agenda includes pickets of abortionists at their homes, invasions of abortion centers for peaceful protest, sit-ins to prevent the killing of children, all-night prayer vigils, a National Day of Mourning, a National Day of Protest against Planned Parenthood's abortion policies, protests against communist China's forced abortion policies, etc.

The pro-life leaders, representing some 10,000 activists vowed to communicate through the newly formed network throughout the year and to work move the entire anti-abortion movement towards direct action and open confrontation with the evil of legalized abortion and its purveyors.
